If no significant pathological or physiological defects are visible within the structure of the tree at the time of inspection then the inspector must mark the relevant Condition Assessment box with N/A or X . If The Condition Assessment box is marked R (Restricted) or UA (Unable to Assess) then the inspector has not been able to assess this part of the tree, notes detailing the nature of the restriction should be made within the box relating to the affected area, any overall condition should be provisional until a further un-restricted inspection is made. . If No Risk score or recommendations are made then the tree requires no further work in line with the Authorities Tree Strategy and Emergent Tree Risk Management Strategy.

Numerical Risk Score is only to be used as a guide and a competent inspector can alter risk scores based upon their findings on the day of assessment.
