| Rationale | The white paper <i>Modernising Social Services</i> sets out the Government's aims to promote the independence and social participation of Social Services users. Supporting people in their own homes is a key part of this agenda. This indicator covers people receiving any amount of care, so is being used to show how much low level care is provided. Such care can prevent or postpone a person needing more intensive care packages or residential care. | | | | |

| Commentary | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Good performance is generally high. ◆ The mid year 2004 population 65+ years is taken as 52502 for the purpose of target setting. ◆ The targets are set to achieve and maintain a 3• performance banding and for 2005/06 would result in 4305 older people helped to live at home as at 31 March. ◆ The figure as at 31st December 2005 totals 3654 older people. (MM) ◆ People receiving day care to be cross-referenced with SWIFT (SB) ◆ People receiving Meals on Wheels to be reconciled against SWIFT (MV) ◆ Report and Action Plan on Process Review Group in October to DMG to raise any possible information collection requirements. (TI) ◆ Definition of Professional Support to be reconfirmed with Team Managers (TI) ◆ Prevention Strategy to be revisited and clear position statement re-endorsed ◆ Improve recording quality; Increase resources. | | | | |
