## Whole Class Instrumental Tuition

- The documentation as outlined in 'Proposals for the implementation of Whole Class Instrumental Tuition' details a model to fully meet the Governments aspirations at a cost to school of between £1300 and £5200 (depending on size of school)
- During discussions at budget working group it became apparent that many schools would be unable to finance the proposal and as such Dudley Performing Arts felt it appropriate to propose an alternative that relied on less budget input from schools

### Alternative Proposal

- Each school will receive one term of whole class instrumental tuition at cost of £150 per class.
- Schools wishing to extend the project to a 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> term would be able to do this at a cost of £575 per class per term.
- This will be achieved by placing more subsidies into the first term.
- The overall cost to schools that decide to extend the project to a full year will remain unchanged
- This proposal will enable all students at Key Stage 2 in Dudley to learn a musical instrument. Schools that are able to extend the project to a year will fully meet government aspirations.
