

Annex – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

Conditions to which existing licence was granted

(b) The prevention of crime and disorder

PROOF OF AGE CARDS ARE ASKED TO BE SUPPLIED IF THERE IS ANY DOUBT AS TO AGE. INTRODUCTION OF CAPACITY LIMITS. TABLES AND CHAIRS ARE IN RATIO TO THE CUSTOMERS IN RESTAURANT AREA.

NOTICES ARE DISPLAYED AS TO RESTRICTIONS ON UNDER AGE DRINKING. STAFF ARE ALL AWARE THAT ALCOHOL IS NOT TO BE SERVED TO UNDER 18's. ALCOHOLIC DRINKS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE TAKEN OFF THE PREMISES EXCEPT WHEN A BOTTLE OF WINE IS PURCHASED WITH A MEAL AND THE CUSTOMER WISHES TO TAKE THE REST OF THE UNFINISHED BOTTLE OF WINE HOME WITH THEM.

(c) Public safety

THE PREMISES HAS THE FACILITY FOR DISABLED ACCESS

FIRE ESCAPE ROUTES ARE MARKED WITH NOTICES

d) The prevention of public nuisance

THE LOCATION OF THE PREMISES IS IN A SMALL VILLAGE WHERE NO NUISANCE IS ANTICIPATED.

(e) The protection of children from harm

ALL STAFF ARE AWARE THAT NO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS OF AGE ARE TO BE SERVED WITH ALCOHOL. IF STAFF ARE IN ANY DOUBT AS TO THE AGE OF A CUSTOMER THE STAFF REQUIRE SIGHT OF PROOF OF AGE CARDS.

Supper hours certificate under se68 of the Licensing Act 1964 for part of the premises has standard condition that the service of alcohol is ancillary to the provision of substantial refreshment during the relevant times

Relevant Times

Monday to Saturday until Midnight

Sunday 12noon until 11:30pm

Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

All conditions set out as in the operating schedule.

- 1. All regulated entertainments from 11.00hrs to 23.00hrs up to three days per week at licensee's discretion**
- 2. The Beer Garden shall be cleared of all glassware at and bottles and no consumption of alcohol and food after 23.00hrs.**
- 3. All doors and windows shall be kept closed during regulated entertainments.**
- 4. All exit doors within the premises to have signs asking customers to leave the premises quietly and respect local residents and their premises**
- 5. Signs in the car park to state:- no ball games, no sounding of horns and to leave the car park quietly**
- 6. No noise from regulated entertainment to be audible to the nearest noise sensitive premises (local residents)**

Unless otherwise specified in the terms and conditions attached, this licence is also subject to any restrictions currently in force under the following enactments:

- Cinematograph (Safety) Regulations 1955
- Sporting Events (Control of Alcohol) Act 1985
